*First such Meeting was organized in well manner chaired by Honorable Chairman CBSE Shri Rajesh Chaturvedi to discuss few important initiatives taken by CBSE which are as follows.*

➤ **Parinam Manjusha – A CBSE Academic Repository**

- First one of its kind and an important landmark ICT initiative.
- Yet another step towards making of Digital CBSE.
- CBSE's digital repository of academic records. At present Two years' academic Records are available i.e. 2015 & 2016. Legacy data will be added gradually.
- Employers and educational institutions can use this repository to verify academic records of CBSE students online.
- The digital academic certificates from this repository will also be available to students through Digi Locker.
- CBSE will give access of its result data to NAD service providers.
- Access of Class X and XII data of 2015 & 2016 will be given for NAD.
- CBSE will continue with its repository, providing digital documents and verification.

➤ **CBSE Logo has been changed. Now Logo will have Bharat Instead of DELHI it will be now BHARAT.**

➤ **Aadhar Number has been made Mediatory for all Students of CBSE and will be used as an Authentication Number for attendance as well as verification of candidates during the examination.**

➤ **Aadhar Number is Mediatory for all Students from PG to XII.**

➤ **City Coordinators are given responsibility to stables Aadhar Centre with help of UID.**

- In this session CBSE will not collect any result of Class IX whether it is of Co-scholastics or Scholastics.
- CBSE will collect Class X (2016 – 2017) results of following performances-
  - FA – I, FA – II, FA – III & FA – IV
  - SA – I and SA – II (who have opted home based)
- CBSE will not collect any co-scholastics data from the schools neither of Class IX nor of class-X.
- CBSE Chairman strictly said that all those who don't follow CBSE bylaws and circulars are free to quite CBSE and are free to take Affiliation from any other board.
- In all competitive examination from now digital attendance will be taken which will authenticate candidates from their Aadhar. Which will stop wrong candidates from the examination? This practice will soon be applicable in board examination also.
- CBSE will use OASIS Data for the following purposes.
  - Fixation of Centres as per the GEO Locations.
  - A GEO Location and Image of the Campus will also send to the candidates which will help them to reach at the venue comfortably.
- All competitive examinations' OMR Sheets will be scanned at the Centres and then will be uploaded on the CBSE Portal in presence of Centre Superintendents, 2 observes, 4 Invigilators and 1 CBSE Representative. The cost of scanning will be paid by CBSE. This will be a very transparent system to prepare the results. Results of Competitive examinations along with the corrected OMR Sheet will also be sent in the digital locker of the candidates and candidates will able to see their scores.
- Almost everything now will be digital for the students, schools and teachers.
- From this session off line award list will not be available for sending the marks obtained by the candidates of board examination of X and XII to the Head Examiners who will be appointed by the board for the evaluation of the answer scripts. They will have to upload the marks online and a duly signed printout of award list will be sent for the record.
